Was able to save crank out when I checked the oil pump it was ok. pulled drive shaft out of pump and held back in engine (made sure it was locked in drive) when I turn engine the shaft moved only a little bit and then went back to where it started from. I know that in the older engines the distributor turned the oil pump drive shaft but what turns them on the new engines? And is there a common problem of something I should be looking
